Anti-Human Artemin Antibody - Additional Information

Preparation

Produced from sera of rabbits pre-immunized with highly pure (>98%) recombinant hArtemin. Anti-Human Artemin specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography employing immobilized hArtemin matrix.

WesternBlot

To detect hArtemin by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of $0.1 - 0.2 \,\mu g/ml$. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant hArtemin is $1.5 - 3.0 \, ng/lane$, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

Sandwich

To detect hArtemin by sandwich ELISA (using 100 μ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.5 - 2.0 μ g/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with BioGems' Biotinylated Anti-Human Artemin (60-067BT) as a detection antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant hArtemin.

Formulation

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Reconstitute in sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

Storage

-20°C

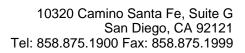
