This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Bovine IgG coupled to agarose beads. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-biotin, anti-Rabbit Serum, Bovine IgG, Bovine IgG F(c) and Bovine Serum. No reaction was observed against Bovine IgG F(ab')2.

Storage Condition

Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.
